Reading

In reading students will be reviewing previously taught reading strategies, such as main idea & details, summarizing, cause & effect, and compare/contrast.

It is beneficial that students read a book of their choice for a minimum of 30 minutes at home every night.

What's Happening in Class

Math:

Students will be reviewing how to create equivalent fractions, adding & subtracting fractions, and other review skills as needed.

All students can log into IXL and work on 5th grade math skills at home for additional practice. It would be very beneficial for students to continue practicing their basic facts at home.

Social Studies:

Students will be finishing our states and capitals unit. Students receive flash cards during class in order to practice memorizing the states and capitals. Students will need to practice studying these at home.
